On arrival board your open safari vehicles for a two hour game drive through Private Game Reserve, a wonderful opportunity to spot rhinoceros, giraffe, buffalo, zebra and rare roan and sable antelope. A light lunch is served on board. After a two hour cruise we head back to shore and then back to the Albert Luthuli International Convention Centre in the early evening

PROGRAMME:

Day 1:

Depart at 07h00 from the Hotel and travel up to Zululand through the various agricultural lands that make up the rural areas of the Province. Witness the contrast between traditional peasant-style, and subsistence agriculture with the vast commercial sugar and timber plantations. This region is redolent with the culture and history of the Zulu people.

Here we visit the St Lucia Estuary, situated in the greater St Lucia Wetland Park. The estuary is a wonderful, wide stretch of water going up some distance to the lake. This is the area which has given St Lucia the “Fisherman’s Paradise” tag. While there are certainly plenty of fish in the estuary, fishing is only one facet of the park’s attractions. The estuary is home to a substantial number of hippos and even more crocs so swimming is not recommended if your insurance has lapsed! But boating is – and what a lot there is to see and experience. The banks of the estuary are lined with mangroves and their life cycle can be read from tree to seed to sapling impaled in the mud. St Lucia Estuary abounds with birdlife, binoculars and a bird book are recommended items to accompany you on this tour. Loeries, weavers, narina trogons and a host of other colourful birds constantly flit to and fro testing your recognition skills to its limits. On the ground hippo and crocs abound, whilst banded mongooses and bushbuck are often seen on the estuary banks. Sit back, relax and enjoy these wonderful sightings on your two hour narrated boat cruise on the flat bottom boat. Lunch stop for clients own account before heading for a Private Lodge for our overnight stay and dinner.

Meals Included: Dinner

Day 2:

After breakfast depart for Hluhluwe Game Reserve the oldest game reserve in South Africa. The park covers 96 000 hectares, and comprises three reserves: Hluhluwe and Umfolozi – two of Africa’s oldest game reserves, both founded in 1895 – and the linking Corridor Reserve, proclaimed in 1989.

Dance to the pulsating sounds of Zulu drums as the GAZA family perform some of their traditional ceremonial Zulu dances. From here it is up to Howick Falls, to view one of the highest falls in Kwazulu Natal. Lunch stop for client's own account.

After lunch we head to the Southern Drakensberg Mountains. The Drakensberg is the country's grandest mountain range. Day 1: PRE Tour Route: Johannesburg to Kruger National Park
